This is to certify that Cardiff Metropolitan University is a recognised institute in the United Kingdom as per Section 124 A (3) and (4) of the Education Reform Act 1988 and the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 (*Annex 1*)

It is further stated that Cardiff Metropolitan University is offering their program which will be delivered by Universal Business School, Kushivili, PO Gaurkamath, Vadap, Karjat - 410201, Dist. Raigad, Maharashtra, India. Under this arrangement the Cardiff Metropolitan University will offer an MBA and BA (Hons) in Business and Management Studies for duration of 12 months and 36 months respectively.

The Qualification Assurance Agency (QAA) has undertaken an institutional audit at Cardiff Metropolitan University. A copy of the report is in *Annex 2*.

The Cardiff Metropolitan University programmes and awards offered in India are the same as those offered in all 51 countries where they have approved Cardiff Metropolitan University Partner centres. These are the same awards certified by the Qualification and Curriculum Development Agency (England) (QCDA) and Office of the examination and Qualifications' regulator (Ofqual). These are also the same programmes they promote on their corporate website and which are articulated against by UK universities or India will have the same standing as any other student completing a qualification in any university in UK in terms of progression to higher qualifications and the job market.
